

School Responsibility

There is no charge or fee to the school for this wonderful experience. The artists will be paid through donors and patrons solicited by Learning CTR Online.

MASTER CLASS

- Offered to the choir and any aspiring singers.
- John will work with singers directly, offering tips and coaching.
- The vocal director will distribute a questionnaire prior to the master class allowing students to ask questions about any aspect of vocal training and profession (business of the business, networking, auditions, agents, performance details, social media, digital marketing, young artist programs, practical application outside the music world, etc.).

SCHOOL ASSEMBLY

- Offered during the school day to all students (*if possible*).
- John will give an abbreviated concert (tantalizer) as a showcase for the evening concert.

FACILITIES / AUDITORIUM

- The school will provide facilities / auditorium for the assembly and evening concert. The school can provide a sound engineer/technician or we can provide our own.
- The **concert** will include a variety of genres, including opera, crossover, musical theatre, spiritual, pop, jazz, rap, etc.
- Admission: \$5 per person or \$10 per family.

FLYERS

- The school will post flyers of the concert in advance (in the school, local businesses, to parents, etc.).
